The Founder travels several times a year to check on the children's welfare and monitor their education. This personal attention creates a bond which helps in each child's development.

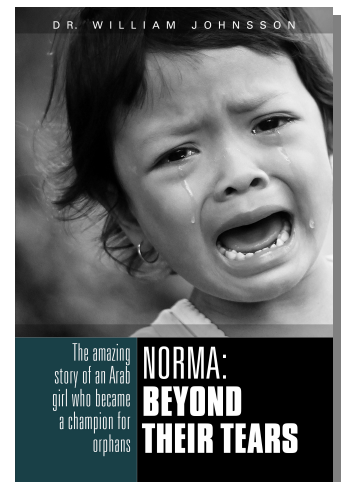
Specifically...
